INSTRUCTIONS TO JUDGES

Please read the "Instructions to Judges" sheet in your packet. Do not forget to select a best actor and actress for each level you judge!

<u>RULES</u>

Entry Limit: 1 skit per level, per school (Levels 1, 2, 3, & 4); there must be a minimum of 3 performers with speaking parts, no maximum.

<u>Time Limits</u>: Levels 1 & 2: 4-8 minutes Levels 3 & 4: 7-10 minutes Contestants have a <u>30-second grace period (under or over)</u>, plus a maximum of 3 minutes to set up.

Mixed-level skits must be entered on the level of the most advanced cast member. **If advantaged speakers are included in a level 4 skit, this information must be given to the judges.** Skits may be written by the class, the teacher, Germanspeaking authors, or others. Skits may be from fairy tales. <u>Good pronunciation and grammatically-correct German are</u> <u>most important in the judging</u>. Costumes and props may be added for flavor and effect, but are not required. Two copies of the script must be provided for the judges <u>Excerpts from the skit may not be reused in other categories by the same</u> <u>cast member</u>.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

- 1. **Selection and preparation**: The selection is interesting and at the appropriate difficulty level. The contestants know their lines well. All the above-listed rules are followed. (0-20 points)
- 2. **Pronunciation**: The contestants' pronunciation of the German language is correct and understandable. The intonation is characteristically German. (0-20 points)
- 3. Voice and diction: The contestants enunciate. Their voices are clear and audible. They use changes in volume, rate, pitch, and inflection. (0-20 points)
- 4. **Blocking, movement, and characterization**: The blocking is adequate and motivated. The actors are poised and avoid unnecessary movements. The contestants clearly and accurately develop the characters. (0-20 points)
- 5. **Overall effect**: The contestants create and maintain a mood. They maintain character and pace. The stage sets, props, costumes, and/or make-up (if any) enhance rather than distract. The performance leaves a lasting impression. (0-20 points)
